

T. RIPPON MID-ESSEX CRICKET LEAGUE

UMPIRES PANEL CONSTITUTION

All persons appointed to matches on the T. Rippon Mid-Essex Cricket League must be paid up members of the ECB Association of Cricket Officials.

All umpires appointed to matches on the T. Rippon Mid-Essex Cricket League are automatically members of the 'panel' for that season.

The 'panel' will normally meet three times per season to discuss things of mutual interest. At least seven days' notice will be given of such meetings by the umpires' appointments secretary.

At the September/October meeting –

1. The umpires' appointments secretary for the following season will be elected. The existing holder will be deemed a candidate, subject only to willingness to stand. Any other nomination must be made in writing to the umpires' appointments secretary by 10 August. If there is not a candidate as detailed then a nomination(s) shall be sought from the floor of the meeting.
2. This constitution may be amended. Any amendment must be submitted in writing to the umpires' appointments secretary by 10 August.

The only persons who may vote on 1 and 2 above are those who have stood in at least five matches as a 'panel' umpire on the T. Rippon Mid-Essex Cricket League in the current season. In addition persons who stood in at least five matches as a 'panel' umpire on the League in the previous season may also vote.
